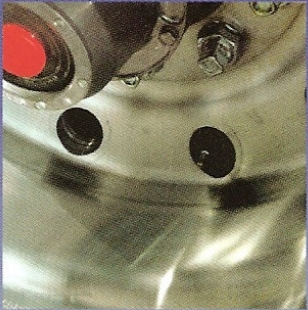
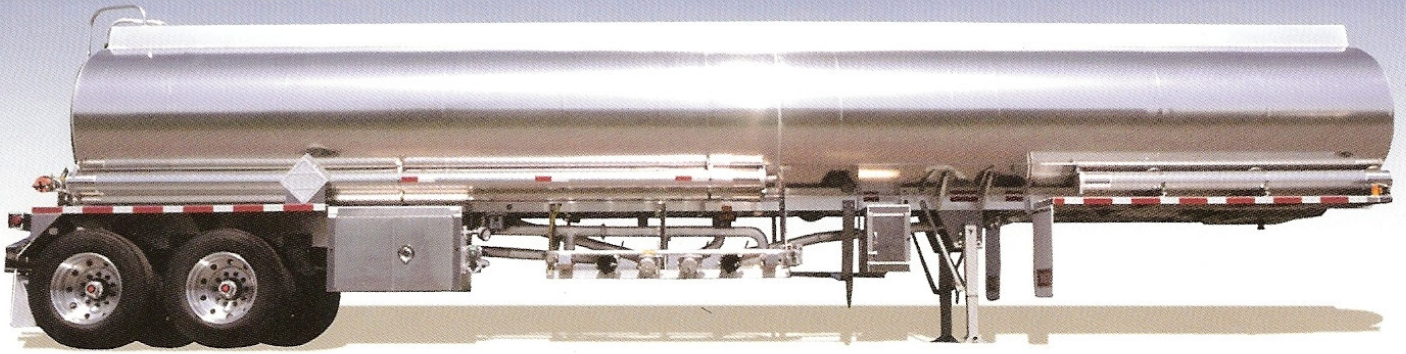

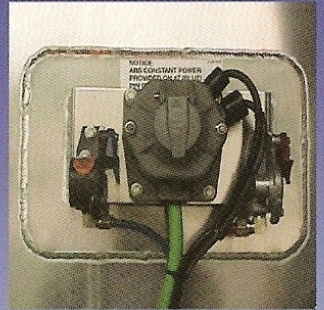
Tire valve extensions are added to allow inside tires to be inflated without difficulty.



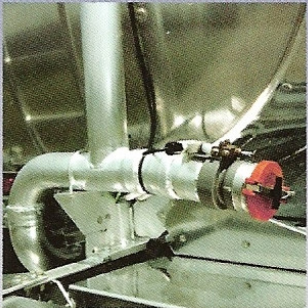
The Heil "Bar Interlock" automatically sets the brakes on the trailer which helps save the operators time and increases safety.



Lighter, removable landing legs aid in user operation and may help with reducing the tractor to trailer hookup time.



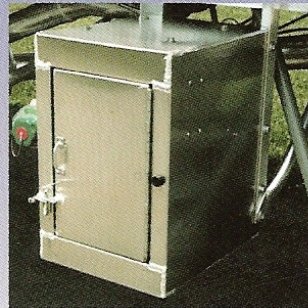
The nosebox is made of lightweight, weather proof composite material and is located within ground reach of the operator.



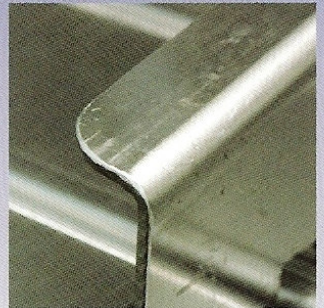
Vapor line outlets are made easily accessible to maximize convenience and may be tilted downward to attach hoses easily.



Hose troughs can be used in place of the standard tubes. They can also be tapered inboard over the work area.



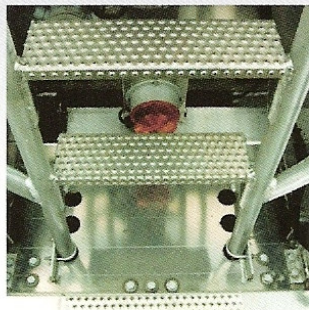
Cabinets can be designed to fit any storage need. Operator cabinet doors automatically interlock vapor vents as an extra safety feature.



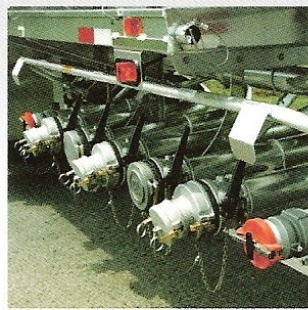
All sharp edges are removed to prevent an often overlooked risk to operators or others who may be around the trailer.



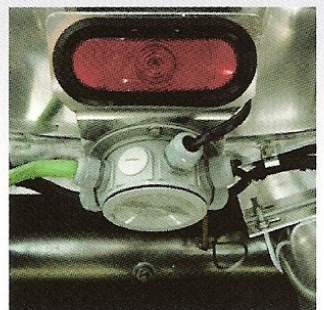
The assist step located below the bumper makes access to and from the ladder more convenient.
